Novice - *Epi. elongatum* - Tony Agrela



Found only on Martinique in the Lesser Antilles, frequently on citrus trees at elevations of 300 to 700 meters altitude and terrestrial amongst mosses above that. It is a natural hybrid between *Epi. cryptopateras* and *Epi. secundum*
Species - *Paph. charlesworthii* - A&G Cushway

Paphiopedilum charlesworthii



A striking presence, this plant grows as a lithophyte in leaf mould on the sides of cool damp limestone cliffs from 1200-2000m of elevation. It is found growing in Assam, Myanmar, Thailand and Southeastern China. The quality of flower, like

many *Paphs* can vary, so always best to acquire plants of a know quality, like this one.



Specimen - *Ornithophora radicans* - Tinka Riddell

From elevations of around 400m in Brazil, *Ornithophora radicans* will multiply quickly into a large plant if kept moist. This is by far the best way to show off its comparatively small flowers.

Hybrid – *Phalaenopsis Unknown* (white) - Angie Sulfaro

Another great *Phalaenopsis* from Angie.
